For postdoctoral researchers

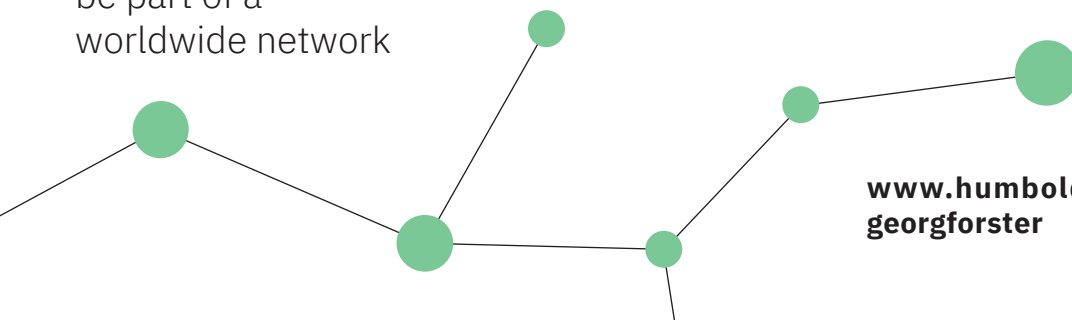
- €2,670 per month
